Fund Update as at 30 June 2018

This fund update was first made publicly available on 3 August 2018.

It is a replacement fund update for the update made publicly available on 27 July 2018. The only change is to clarify that the total management and administration charges in the section headed "What fees are investors charged?" are actual, not estimated, figures.

What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how Summer New Zealand Fixed Interest has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the fund with other funds. 
Description of this fund




Example of how this applies to an investor

Kim had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Kim received a return after fund charges were deducted but before tax of \$415 (that is 4.15% of her initial \$10,000). Kim also paid \$36 in other charges. This gives Kim a total return after tax of \$261 for the year.
